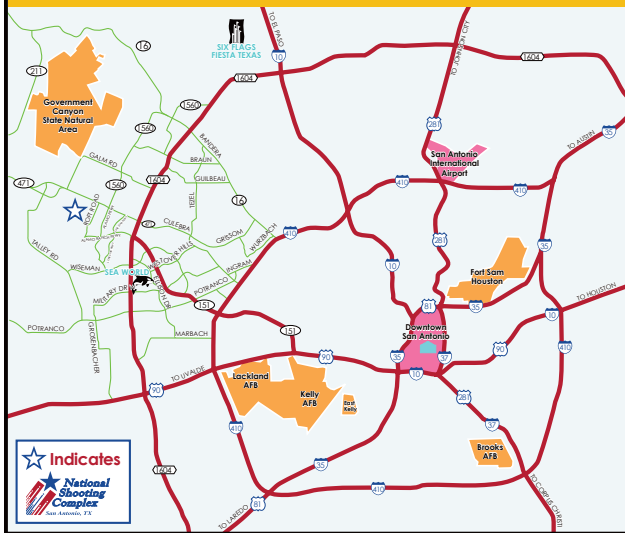


SAN ANTONIO MAP

GENERAL INFORMATION

PROGRAM CHANGES

Any part of this shoot program may be changed by Shoot Management. Notices of any change(s) will be posted at the Registration office. It is the shooter's responsibility to become aware of any change.

RULES, REGULATIONS & PROTESTS

This shoot is registered by the NSSA and their rules will govern. All participants must have paid their current NSSA/NCSA dues before being allowed to compete in this tournament. There will be no exceptions. Texas residents must be current members of TSSA.

Squads will not be called. It is the shooter's responsibility to be at the correct field on time. Shooters missing their scheduled squad time run the risk of not completing the event. Shooters missing their squad will be allowed to join their squad in a subsequent round and finish the event by his or herself provided, in the opinion of the referee, there is sufficient time before the next flight. If there is not time, they will be moved to the last flight of the day.

Shoot management may refuse or cause withdrawal of any contestant who annoys, endangers or interferes in any way with the harmony of the shoot or, in Management's opinion, whose conduct is unsportsmanlike. All protests must be presented to the Protest Committee within thirty minutes after the flight is finished. The Protest Committee will consist of the NSSA Director and representatives from the shoot.

PAYMENT

NSC will accept CASH or CHECK ONLY for shoot options – credit cards will be accepted for all other services.

LIABILITY

Participants and spectators recognize the exposure to potential injury associated with shotgun sports and assume all risks of accidents while attending this tournament. Shoot Management stresses the need for precaution concerning theft. We recommend that you do not leave any shotgun in your vehicle after leaving the NSC grounds. NSC does not assume responsibility for theft at any time or place.

SHOTGUN STORAGE

Secure storage is available for participants' guns. Cost is \$5 per day per case with no more than two guns per case.

SHOOT-OFFS

All ties involving money and/or points will be shot off. Winners will be determined by doubles on stations 3, 4 & 5 miss and out by station. NSSA rules will govern.

REFEREES

This tournament will use professional referees. The Briley Voice Release, known as "The Wand," will be available on all competition and practice fields. Squads will have the option of voice release or manual referee pulls. Calls made by the referee will stand unless presented to the Protest Committee for review.

AMMUNITION

Ammunition will be available for purchase at the ammo building. Hand loads will be permitted and NSSA rules will be observed.

PROOFS

Proof shells will NOT be provided by NSC.

16-25 Shooters - 50-30-20%
26 + Shooters - 40-30-20-10%

PAYMENT

NSC will accept CASH or CHECK ONLY for shoot options – credit cards will be accepted for all other services.

OPTIONAL PURSES & EVENTS - (available in all events)

Oklahoma Option by Class - \$15 each event, all money returned; ties divide.

Champion of Champions - Total score of last round in each of the 4 guns \$10, all money returned; ties divide.

Optional Class Purse - High Gun System, split as shown above; all money returned; ties divide. \$10 each event.

Optional Concurrent Purse - High Gun System, all money returned; ties divide. \$10 per event.

Handicap Option - Entry Fee: \$10 per event
All money returned to shooters, divided equally among shooters tied for top score. Maximum Score = 100 targets per event.

NSC Building Lewis Purse - 3 classes \$10 - 50% NSC, 50% Shooters.

Kids & Clays (RMH) Lewis Purse - 3 classes \$20 - 50% K&C, 50% Shooters.
