The entry fee for each event is \$45.00 which includes purse (\$5.00 to class-\$2.00 to Gun Champion) and all fees. Purse split is 1-5 shooters – winner takes all, 6-10 – split 60/40, 11 or more – 50/30/20.

General Information

-This facility is open to NSSA members who are pre-registered. Non military ID card holders will be required to pick-up passes at the front gate. One pass per vehicle required.

-This shoot is a registered tournament and will be conducted according to the current NSSA rules. The shoot will be officiated by experienced referees.

- All events will be shot by the rotation system. Shooters are urged to pre-register in a desired rotation as soon as possible.

-Entries will be closed when club management feels it has a sufficient number of shooters.

- Entrants must state their **CONCURRENT EVENT** entry with team members at the time of registration. Teams are not required to shoot on the same rotation.

- Ties for Gun championship awards, class championships, concurrent championships, and identical long runs will be shot off in doubles from 3, 4, & 5 miss and out by station for all gauges. Long-runs front or back, except HOA will determine all other ties. Shoot-offs shall take precedence over long runs.

- Limited shells will be available for sale at the club. Shooters are encouraged to preorder

needed ammunition. Reloads permitted subject to inspection, and shooters must furnish shoot-off shells. Empty shells become the property of the club once they hit the ground.

- Spectators and contestants assume all risk resulting from accident or loss of property occurring on the club grounds.

-Practice rounds available at Club for \$5.00 per round. Practice available daily at 0800.

- Shoot management decisions regarding the shooting events are final.

- In keeping with the professionalism, camaraderie, spirit, and harmony in North Carolina Shoots, shoot management reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.

The shooting complex invites all shooters and guests to dinner on Saturday following the 20 gauge event. Please advise the number attending dinner when pre-registering. The club is located on Old Sawmill Road and is approx one mile inside the front gate. Turn left at the second traffic light. There is a small sign that says shooting complex just before that light.
