It is time to begin work staffing the 2011 **WORLD SKEET CHAMPIONSHIPS**, which will be held on September 30th through October 7th at the National Shooting Complex, San Antonio, Texas. We look forward to hearing from you by September 1, 2011.

Your application for the World Skeet Championships is enclosed. We need world class referees at this event. Please make sure you indicate the days you can attend by circling the dates on your application. Consideration will be given those who can attend the entire shoot, over those who cannot.

We are looking for 6 more referees to Iron Man for the Mini World Saturday and Sunday only; if you are capable of working straight through, please indicate if you are willing and able to meet this requirement.

We need four referees to work only Monday (whole day plus shoot-offs); if you are able to meet this requirement, please indicate so on your application. We need 2 referees Saturday and Sunday for the whole day plus shoot-offs.

We need more referees for the Mini-World so if you want to work just the Mini-World on Saturday and Sunday, please indicate so on your application. We may also need 9 referees for the last flight of the Champ of Champs on Friday, October 7th.

We will be having the Referee Event on Friday, September 30<sup>th</sup> at 9:00am. There will be a MANDATORY Referee Meeting in the Stadium on Friday, September 30<sup>th</sup> at 10:30 a.m. The Briley Wand will be used in both the Mini and Main Events. MANDATORY training will be conducted immediately following the meeting. Your attendance is required. Any Referee Event Shoot-offs will be announced regarding date and time.

Please indicate in the proper block your preference as a shooting or non-shooting referee. However, the current plan is to staff the shoot with non-shooting referees. Shooting referees will not be used unless there is a shortage of non-shooting referees.

NSSA is expecting an excellent attendance at the 2011 World Shoot and I would like to have as many referees return as possible.

The Mini World begins on Friday, September 30th with Doubles. The 12 and 28 gauges will be on Saturday, and the 20 gauge and .410 bore on Sunday. The Referee Event will be held on Friday, September 30th. The Main Events commence with the 12 gauge on Monday, 20 gauge on Tuesday, 28 gauge on Wednesday and the .410 bore on Thursday. The Champion of Champions and Doubles Events will be on Friday.

Note: Referees will be paid by check. Arrangements have been made with HEB to cash checks if necessary.
