EVENT NAMESAKE:
Frank Christopher DeCicco Jr.

Frank DeCicco (1923-2004) was an American war hero. He served as a waste gunner in the 427th Bomb Squadron, 303rd Bomb Group, 8th Air Force between 1944 and 1945 and was shot down twice in enemy territory. DeCicco completed 31 missions and ended his military career as a staff sergeant.

He was also accomplished in real estate, founding RE/MAX of Texas with his wife Jean in 1977.
